



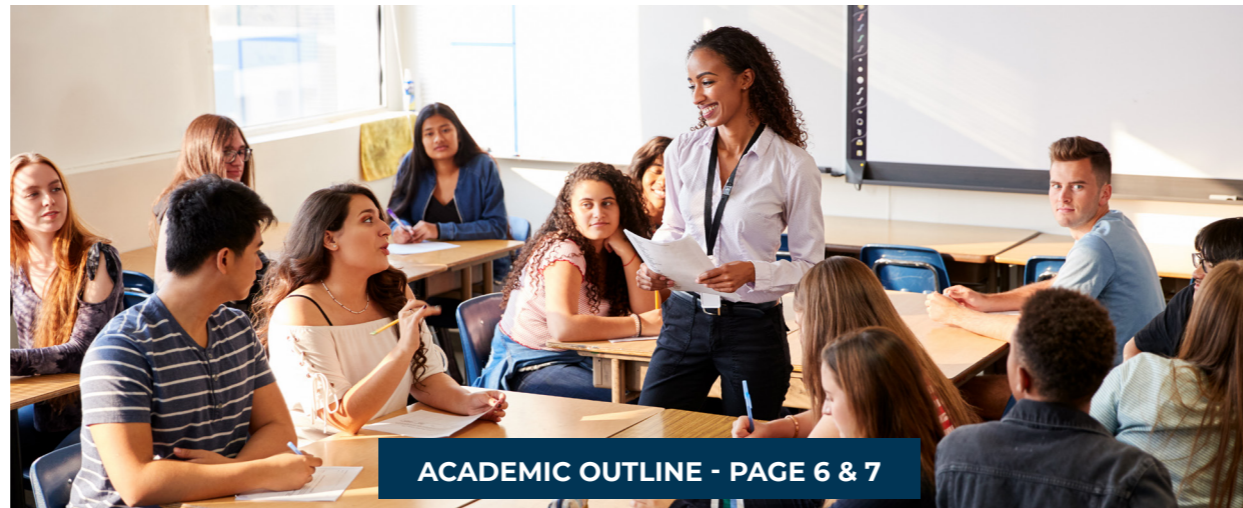

# Academic OUTLINE

## Learn English and more

Our classes focus on all English language skills and get every student speaking a lot. They will also learn about the life and culture of the country they are staying in, so students will get a better understanding of the UK depending on where they are staying, whilst becoming better English speakers.

Every class is based around a topic and theme linked to British life and culture and students learn how to use the English language in everyday, true to life situations. English is the only language always used in the camps. To be fully effective, lessons at ABC Education Group are challenging, interactive and great fun! Our teachers will use a range of teaching techniques to ensure students can participate fully in the classroom and have continued opportunities to learn, improve and practise, practise, practise. Students are divided into classes by age and level so that your children can mix with others of a similar age and language ability. Every class is taught by two teachers, one before the break and one after so that students enjoy a range of teaching styles and get to experience more than only one teacher.

## How we Teach

Students will be learning in many ways and we will try to make sure that lessons help them get the most out of their excursions around the UK, that are an important part of our programme. We will teach English that will help them find their way around, learn about the museums and famous places they visit and language that will help them enjoy their time here. Classes will include information about British culture, famous people and sports. We want everyone to go home not just with better English but with a better understanding of Great Britain.

## Project-based Learning

At the end of each week each student delivers a presentation showing off what they have learned from their lessons, excursions and activities. This final project is worked on throughout the week and encourages the students to think creatively and put into active use everything they have learned. The final presentation provides a goal for every student and encourages independent thinking and allows each learner to focus on things they care about and are inspired by whilst activating all their English language skills. This project-based approach means they are developing valuable life skills as well as their English language.

All our teachers are qualified (e.g. a minimum of the Cambridge CELTA plus a degree) and are also trained ABC in how to use our syllabus and get the best out of every lesson. We care about every individual and want them to achieve their learning goals.

All students receive a certificate and an individual learning outcomes report written by their teachers at the end of their course.

# Social & CULTURAL ACTIVITIES

## Social Programme

After each lesson your child will enjoy an activity or excursion, all designed to get children enjoying themselves whilst using their learned English. There are lots of activities for students to socialize and learn with each other including excursions so students can see and learn about the UK. These excursions are often linked to the days lesson topic.

We provide excursions from our camps that allow students to see and learn about the UK, connecting the language to the place. We believe in inspiring language learners by showing them what makes Britain great.

Activities include karaoke, Great British quizzes, discos, talent shows and game nights. Using the English language in these fun and engaging sessions helps each learner to really use and remember everything they have been taught. Students might discover a hidden talent or try something completely new, and they are the perfect time to practice their English with their new international friends. Our unique, task-based learning means that everything students do and see outside the classroom can be used in their final presentation. Our aim is for every child to learn both in and out of the classroom whilst they are with us.

## Cultural Programme

Excursions are often to another town or city where students will learn about the history and culture of each location. These trips are typically in a private coach but can sometimes be by train. Students are supervised throughout the trip and are given clear instructions of where to meet and at what time during the day. If you study in London, you might get a day at the seaside in Brighton or a trip to Oxford to see the oldest university in the UK. However, if you study in Brighton, you will visit the capital city itself, London, with its fantastic mix of culture, historical buildings and modern architecture.

All of these trips outside of the classroom are carefully managed and organized by ABC's Activity team with students' safety always the priority. Led by the Activity Manager and his/her team of Activity Leaders who make sure everyone is included, and maximum enjoyment is had. Our management team are all experienced and trained in safeguarding and first aid. Our Activity Leaders also receive safeguarding and risk assessment training.

## University Campuses

While two University campuses are never the same, we carefully select our summer centers to ensure they offer the high standards that ABC demand and so will allow students to have a great experience they will never forget. We offer a range of locations that will suite every taste; In Brunel University you are less than 60 minutes from central London, whilst at the University of Brighton, you are a short bus ride away from the beach and vibrant town center.

Our centers all offer modern facilities and as safeguarding is our number one priority, are in safe surroundings. They are all within easy reach of public transport or within walking distance of town centers. Some of the other facilities, such as sports and other options vary but there are many communal areas for students to relax in and a good selection of cafes and shops on campus. All our sites offer Wi-Fi access, so everyone can keep their social media up to date!

## Accommodation

Students will stay in either en-suite or standard rooms. All the bedrooms have a bed, wardrobe, desk and chair. En-suite rooms offer the luxury of a private bathroom. All bedrooms and bathrooms are cleaned weekly, which includes a change of bed linen. Bedrooms are part of a flat, these flats can vary from 4 to 8 individual bedrooms, but all have a kitchen and communal area, which can be a great place to relax at the end of the day. The kitchens are not functional except for the use of fridges. There is always an on-site laundry where students can wash their own clothes, the costs vary but it is approximately £5 per wash and dry.

## Classrooms

All the classrooms are equipped with whiteboards (many are interactive or digital nowadays) and are large enough so that students can break out to do group work. All the material is provided for the students, and they are each given a folder to keep their work, so that they can continue their studies after the course.

We know how important food is for young people, especially when they are away from home. We always aim to offer a wide variety of food in both residence and homestay accommodation.

## Residence

- For breakfast, there is a continental breakfast of cereal, bread, fruit and yogurt, along with juices and a selection of hot drinks.
- For lunch and dinner, there is a hot meal, including a vegetarian option, with side dishes. A salad bar is always on offer with fruit, salad vegetables, and either cold meat, cheese or eggs.
- On excursion days, we provide a packed lunch/meal with a filled sandwich, fruit and a drink.

## **One Commitment**

At ABC we have students and staff from all over the world and we want all our students to feel comfortable, happy, safe and free from discrimination. The happiness, welfare and progress of every student and member of staff in our summer camp is our top priority. Every student and member of staff should show respect to each other regardless of any differences. We are an international community, and we believe in celebrating any differences we have and learn from each other.

## **Safeguarding and Welfare**

At ABC our priority is doing everything we can to make every student's experience the best and safest it can be.

Students can learn English, have fun and boost their confidence, all within the safety of our care. All our staff are DBS checked and trained in Prevent Duty, welfare and safeguarding as well as how to care for students 24/7.

There is a 24-hour emergency contact phone number, and our staff care about every individual and know that being available to speak to and be listened to is a key part of our commitment to every student.

Safety and security in and outside the camps is very important. We have policies and procedures that we follow to keep everyone safe, including fire safety, first aid and what to do in emergencies.

All these policies are available to students and parents. Our Student Handbook and inductions for every student make it clear what every student needs to do to have a safe and fun time while with us. We also do a short test with every student to make sure they understand the rules and know who they can speak to if they have any worries, concerns, problems or feel homesick. Our camps are for junior students aged 12-17. We occasionally receive requests for students outside of our minimum/maximum age range who wish to come as part of a group. We review each of these special requests individually and undertake a risk assessment to ensure it will not negatively affect the safeguarding and welfare of anyone in our centers. Final decisions will be made by the Designated Safeguarding Lead and the Admissions Team will notify the requesting party of the outcome.

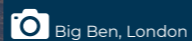
